FREE SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM The Resident Services Dept. is currently hosting the free summer lunch program, sponsored by the Greenville County School District and funded by the Dept. of Agriculture. The program provides a free lunch each day at Westview Homes for the children of Westview and Brookhaven. Between 35 and 45 children participate daily.



MFUGE High School and college students from all over the US participate each year in MFuge, a summer missions program at North Greenville University. These volunteer camp counselors spend several hours each day at Westview Homes providing games and recreation for the children of Westview and Brookhaven. They bring with them basketballs, jump ropes, sidewalk chalk, board games, books, arts & crafts, and outdoor waters games, such as water balloons & sprinklers. Approximately 20 volunteers come to play with the children each week during the summer, making the ratio of counselors to children about 1:2. The children eagerly anticipate the arrival of the counselors each day, and benefit greatly from the focused, individualized attention.



Spelling Bee!

Fourteen-year-old Heavenly Wyatt, a resident of Brookhaven, participated in the state Housing Authority Spelling Bee sponsored by the Beaufort Housing Authority. Heavenly competed against children from all over the state of SC, coming in 2nd place, and bringing home the 2nd place medal for her age group.
